"Chill Bubble Tea is a new concept that brings our most popular drink, bubble tea, from Europe and Asia into the states. We serve bubble tea, which is a tea based smoothie made of fruits, blended creams and ice. It is served cold, like a smoothie, and contains small tapioca balls at the bottom of the drink. They are sucked up through a fat straw, which makes bubble tea a unique and tasty alternative to typical smoothies or even ice cream. It's tough to explain, but customers get hooked on them after trying one of our drinks. Very good stuff...



We have been getting a great response. We opened about 3 months ago and are already attracting 300+ customers every day, and even more on the weekends. We have customers that have been coming in EVERYDAY since we opened, and many customers take 3 or 4 drinks to go. We are anticipating 500-700 customers daily in the summer time.

So far we have over 87 flavors grazing our enormous menu. Our customers like the classics, such as strawberry, mango, banana and cafe mocha. Some of our more exotic flavors such as pina colada, papaya, thai coconut and purple Oreo are also a big hit with our customers.

We've lined the interior with leather sofas and very unique furniture. The design is contemporary and very relaxing. Hip music and a 50 inch plasma television hang in our restaurant to give our



customers a relaxed and fun feel every visit. Customers can order, hang out and watch as our drink specialists cut fruit and make each and every drink from scratch. We usually have a line out the door on weekends or when the weather is nice out.

I think that Morton Grove is a great location for our business. We plan to open 3-4 more stores this year if all goes according to plan. We're attracting customers from as far as Vernon Hills and Gurnee. It brings a lot of traffic and diversity back to Morton Grove. We are very happy to be here in Morton Grove."


